Studley Entaco Green Report November / December 2019 – January 2020

Thur 21 Nov

George went over the green with the mower took off approx one barrow-full of cuttings, followed up with the sorrel roller.

Started off first brew of compost tea.

<u>Fri 22 Nov</u>

Sprayed the green with the first brew of compost tea.

Sat 23 Nov

Applied second brew of compost tea.

<u>Mon 25 Nov</u>

Started off third batch of compost tea

<u>Tue 26 Nov</u>

Applied third brew of compost tea, afterwards cleaned and sterilised compost tea equipment. Lot of rain over the last few days according to the rain gauge there has been 17mm of rain over the last five days.

Colour of the green looks good and the effects of the Fuserium seem to be diminishing.

<u>Thu 28 Nov</u>

Along with George went over the green with the aerator with the large pencil tines.

Mon 30 Dec

Cut the green took of thee barrow-fulls of cuttings. Sprayed the green with Seavolution.

Tue 31 Dec

Changer the tines on the aerator to the slit tines and went over the green. Carried out minor repairs to the green.

<u>Thu 9 Jan</u>

M.G.M came and collected the mower to take it to be serviced. Phoned John Mullins and ordered 20 ltr of Feromex.

Mon 13 Jan

Brushed off the green intending to spray with Feromex moss treatment but started to rain so left it until the afternoon.

Wed 15 Jan

Inspected the green Feromex appears to be working o.k.

<u>Fri 17 Jan</u>

Inspected green, moss dying off well. Went over the green with the whip to disperse worm casts.
